

## 5 New Year's Resolutions for Artists By Dawn M. Wayand

The New Year is just around the corner. Have you thought of any New Year's resolutions you would like to accomplish next year? The possibilities are endless but below are a few resolutions to get you started for the year 2011. Enjoy and good luck!

**Resolution #1:** Take time out of that busy day and set aside 30 minutes a day to do something creative; whether it's zipping through a new gallery, reading an article from an art journal, planning a new painting, finishing an old one or jotting down some ideas in your art journal or sketchbook.

**Resolution #2:** If you confine yourself to a studio to produce, try plein-air painting. The great outdoors will not only give you a breath of fresh air but a new perspective on subjects.

**Resolution #3:** Try exploring an unfamiliar medium. If you usually paint in acrylics, try oil. If you are a photographer, try drawing one of your photographs. Expanding your skill set will help you grow as an artist.

Resolution #4: Treat yourself every once in a while to a new luxury such as a larger canvas or a fine new paintbrush.

**Resolution #5:** Get involved in a local art show. Even if you do not think your work is good enough, your confidence will grow and you might be surprised at just how good your art really is.

## In the Spotlight: 8 Things You Didn't Know About Frank Bolock Interview by Dawn M. Wayand

Hometown: Pittsburgh, PA / He has lived in Tampa Bay Since 2001 Media: Acrylics and Watercolor

DW: How old were you when you first dabbled in the arts?

FB: I was a teenager when I took up an interest in drawing comic strips.

**DW: Who are your major influences or role models in the art world? FB:** Norman Rockwell, Salvatore Dali, Edward Hopper and Edgar Degas

**DW: What is the best thing about being an artist? FB: I** like the creativity that is involved in producing my work.

DW: How close do people get when interpreting your art as opposed to what you art was meant to be interpreted as?

FB: It is very rare. People tend to draw their own conclusions about the meaning behind my work and I'm OK with that.

DW: How do you choose a title for your pieces? FB: I have a very fertile imagination but usually my title evolves from the painting itself.

DW: Do you have any advice for aspiring artists? FB: Getting into the art scene is not easy - you have to know what you are up against. If you love it enough though, keep at it. My number one piece of advice is to network as much as you can.

Frank Bolock is an accomplished acrylic and watercolor artist. A native of Pittsburgh, PA - he has lived in the Tampa Bay area since 2001. He has amassed a body of work since the 1970's and pursued fine arts full time since 1997. Since that time, his work has been accepted into countless national exhibits and he has been the recipient of a number of awards. Currently, he teaches watercolor classes at the Life Enrichment Center in Tampa and is Exhibition Director for the Tampa Regional Artists in addition to gallery shows, demos and workshops.
