

Overcoming Creative Blocks By Dawn M. Wayand

Often times we experience that lull in our artist production called a "creative block", when we cannot seem to get inspired to come up with an idea to work on a new piece or even finish a piece we have already started. Although it feels, at the time, like the end of the world (or the end of our art careers), there is hope. Below are a few tips to overcome a creative block and to get back on the track of producing your very best work.

- Create a piece inspired by anything maybe something lying around the house even if it doesn't interest you. As long as you are getting your juices flowing, you are on the road to recovery.
- Experiment with new media. If you paint in oils, try acrylic. If you paint with acrylic, try mixed media. If you are into photography, try drawing one of your photographs. Again, getting your juices flowing in anything puts you on the road to production again.
- Keep an art journal to record your ideas for paintings or photography to refer back to when you have creative blocks.
- Take an art class that forces you to produce in a structured environment. You may find class assignments opening that creative door again.
- Start with the basics again. Sometimes a creative block is brought on by anxiety of not being able to produce at a level previously achieved. It is not failing to start over. It is an opportunity to take a new direction.
- Take a field trip to a local museum. By putting yourself back into an artistic environment where you can admire other works, inspiration will follow.
- Paint or photograph something you previously painted or photographed from a new perspective. Monet spent much of his time painting the same thing over and over at different times of the day and from different angles.
- Have patience. Creative blocks are a time to take a breather and provide an opportunity to possibly roam in a new direction.
